Fractions

The following fractions are provided; to construct additional ones, connect the superior and inferior numerals with the slash.

G = 1/4

H = 1/2

I = 3/4

J = 1/8

K = 3/8

L = 5/8

M = 7/8

N = 1/3

O = 2/3

Superior Numerals

While pressing both the SHIFT and OPTION keys, type the appropriate number.

shift-option 1 = superior 1

shift-option 2 = superior 2

shift-option 3 = superior 3

etc.

Inferior Numerals

While pressing the SHIFT key type the appropriate number.

shift 1 = inferior 1

shift 2 = inferior 2

shift 3 = inferior 3

etc.

Superior Letters (Ordinals)

Used for abbreviations in Spanish, French and English, such as “nd” for setting “2nd”: (Type the lower case keys.)

a = superior a

b = superior b

d = superior d

e = superior e

h = superior h

i = superior i

l = superior l

m = superior m

n = superior n

o = superior o

r = superior r

s = superior s

t = superior t

Note: Earlier versions of Eidetic contained small cap letterforms in the lowercase keys and ordinals were accessed as follows:

opt.-shift-**a** = superior a

opt.-shift-**b** = superior b

opt.-shift-**d** = superior d

opt.-shift-**e** = superior e

opt.-shift-**i** = superior i

opt.-shift-**l** = superior l

opt.-shift-**m** = superior m

opt.-shift-**n** = superior n

opt.-shift-**o** = superior o

opt.-shift-**r** = superior r

opt.-shift-**s** = superior s

opt.-shift-**t** = superior t

Type the upper case characters:

U D F B A T S E Q

C = copyright symbol

P = music publishing rights symbol

R = registered symbol

Tabular Numerals

Lining numerals with proportional character spacing ideal for use in annual report columns and other tabular applications; type the number keys.

Definitions:

Tabular Numerals

Tabular numerals, also called “mono spaced” numerals, have proportional character spacing and are ideal for use in annual report columns and other tabular applications. (Tabular numerals may be either old style or lining.)

Old Style Numerals

Old style numerals, also called “non-lining,” have ascenders and descenders like the lowercase letters, with emphasis along the x-height, thus creating a more even appearance than lining numerals when used within lowercase text.

Lining Numerals

Lining numerals are all aligned with the height of the capital letters.
